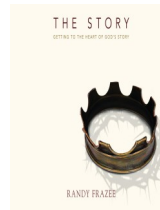
AT OUR CHURCH

How do I complete the survey and participate? Pick up a book, fill out the card, join a small group and start reading. The card helps us to know who is participating and it gets you signed up for emails and/or text alerts.
