Wouldn't it be great if we all could look into our crystal balls and see just what is on the horizon for our lives, our family or our church? Some of us have often dreamed of such an ability. However, only God knows our futures. You see God is sovereign. In fact, of His many qualities, three stand out. They are: All-Powerful (omnipotent), All-knowing (omniscient), and All-Present (omnipresent). The Bible tells us that all of His abilities are really beyond our comprehension. And to think, after considering just how GREAT our GOD is, that in His infinite wisdom, God still desires to have a relationship with the likes of us, who are limited is so many ways. It is this relationship that fascinates me so much.

"Oh, God of the stars the sun and the moon; Oh God of the wind and the sea. Though You're everywhere how amazing it is that you can be hear with me." The uncharted planets and craters beyond, You know like the palm of Your hand. And yet You're concerned with my little world, Lord help me to understand."

God has established and sustains this relationship out of His GREAT LOVE for each of us. It is in and through this relationship that God desires to work through us - through me! One phrase that I've heard often goes something like this, "Without God we CAN-NOT." Yet, "Without us God WILL-NOT." You see, God chooses to work though us.

This past year has been a year of FAITH. Faith in our God who will never leave us nor forsake us. He stopped looking back, and looked forward instead. He didn't let the fear of failure keep him from trying again.

My dear brothers and sisters of SPL, New Year's is a time to learn to rely more heavily on the grace of God. Trust in God's help. One (not-so) secret from the Apostle Paul: "I can do everything through Him who gives me strength," he said (Phil 4:13, NIV). And God's strength saw him through a lot--through pain, through joy, and through accomplishment.

If this last year, you didn't practice relying on the Lord as much as you should have, there is no time like the present to make a New Year's resolution. In fact, why don't you say a short prayer right now--use these words if you like: "Dear God, I want the new year to be different for me." Now spell out in prayer some of the changes you'd like to see. And close this way: "Lord Jesus, I know that I'm going to need a lot of help for this. So right now I place myself in your hands. Help me to receive Your strength. Amen." Good. Now you've got a much better chance of a Happy New Year.




