Any man can be a father. It takes someone special to be a Dad. Dad, is a son's first hero, a daughter's first love. Rose O'Kelly wrote: "Your Dad is the man who does all the heavy shoveling for your sand castle, and then tells you you've done a wonderful job."

This month we celebrate Father's Day. I want to go on record saying that Dad's are critical to the raising of sons and daughters. I don't need to have that verified by Government studies. The Lord God knows that neither fathers nor mothers are handed an owner's manual or a quick start guide when they first become parents. They usually model what they learned from their parents. God provides priorities as what we are to say and what we are to do.

He instructed his O.T. people too: "Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds, tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Teach them to your children, talk about them when you sit down at home, when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up...."

With those words God was letting his fathers and mothers know that no matter what they say or don't say, no matter what they give their children, they must first and foremost give them His word. Toys will not fill the spiritual hole in a child's heart.

God wants and expects Christian fathers to be the prime protectors, the first line of defense for the children placed in their care. Fathers are to leave their children a legacy of love. They are to provide a safe haven in a world that would destroy the child's self worth and self esteem.

Satan knows this is God's desire, which is why Satan so often makes Christian father's his first and foremost targets. The forces of darkness bring their best and most effective weapons against Christian fathers. Seduction and sin, complacency or passivity, self absorption will all lead to discord, disharmony and insecurity. If Satan can stop a father from giving his children attention and a structured frame work for right and wrong behavior, then you have chaos, and anarchy that will spread to all of culture.

Norman Wright in his book "A Dad-Shaped Hole in My Heart" notes that Jairus, an official at the synagogue, came to Jesus with a desperate plea for his daughter, who was deathly ill. Wright reminds us that daughters were not highly valued in Jairus's day (the same problem exists today in China, Tibet and India.) By seeking out Jesus he was exposing himself to ridicule for going to so much trouble over an insignificant girl. God wants us to know that his love is available for those who have been wounded by an absent or passive father. Our Father in Heaven is like Jairus...he goes all out for his sons and daughters.

Many daughters and sons do feel abandoned and forgotten by their fathers. Whether their fathers are simply emotionally absent or are physically absent due to divorce, or death. An emptiness is left in the heart where a father's love should be.

There is only one perfect father: Our Father in heaven. And it is important to know that He has never stopped being YOUR heavenly Father. He will never leave you nor forsake you. He will constantly guide, and discipline you in love. His desire is for you to be a man or woman after His own heart. And perhaps the greatest testimony of His love and commitment to all of us is that His desire is to live with us for all time in the eternal kingdom. Now, I know that our earthly fathers are not perfect but you can help your son or daughter have self-esteem, security, personal value found in the grace of Jesus and displayed through you.

By identifying the specific traits you possess in each of these areas, the ministry God has for you will become clearer than ever.


Goals: Discovering S.H.A.P.E. will be one of the most significant journeys in our walk with Jesus Christ. Throughout this journey we will strive to:
